April 25, 2026**

I. CALL TO ORDER. The Board of Directors meeting was called to order by President Andrew Bielman at 11:00am.

II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES. MOTION by Loraine Malloy, **SUPPORT** by Al Magyar, to approve the minutes of the October 25, 2025 Board meeting.

III. REPORTS

A. President – Andrew Bielman: Covered under Old and New Business.

B. Treasurer – Trish Magyar for Kathy Warner:

Checkbook balance as of April 22, 2026 – \$14,969.21

Lifetime Member Account as of April 22, 2026 – \$4,509.97 with 60 lifetime members. It

was asked if Bill Brengle and Jim Van Eaton were still alive. If not, then either or both need to be removed from the list. (Note: Subsequent Google search indicated that Jim Van Eaton passed away in January 2024; nothing was found regarding Bill Brengle.)

CD – Reinvested \$10,000 February 9, 2026 for seven months at 4.06%. Opted to hold back \$5,000 from the previous CD to ensure there were sufficient funds available to cover the cost of the multi-year purchase of State Shoot awards.

Need to confirm with Kathy Warner that the numbers provided year-to-year are at approximately the same time of the year, on or around April of each year (i.e., previous year data is not year-end).

D. Committee Reports

1. **Constitution & Bylaws** – Sean Rosencrantz: No report.
2. **Finance** – Andrew Bielman: Covered under Treasurer’s report.
3. **State Shoot** – Trish Magyar: Discussion deferred to new business.
4. **Nominations & Elections** – Jim Berg: Have reached out to a couple of possible candidates who have said they “will think about it”. Current Directors up for re-election have all indicated they will run (Ryan Cordes, Jimmy Grimes, Trish Magyar, Loraine Malloy and Sean Rosencrantz). Will continue to solicit other interested individuals.
5. **Hall of Fame** – Al Magyar: This year’s inductee is Chris Baning for the Chet Crites Service Award. Have not received any nominations for 2027 yet.
6. **All-State Teams** – Trish Magyar: Teams were posted on the website late-February.
7. **Awards & Trophies** – Trish Magyar: State Team plaques at DGC are up-to-date.
8. **Social Media/Website** – Trish Magyar: Loraine Malloy has heard comments about the newsletter not being published monthly. In order to reduce the demands on the President’s time, suggested that Board members take turns writing a newsletter. Will need a photo from everyone so it can be included in the write-up. Andrew Bielman will write May’s newsletter, followed by Ryan Cordes for June. Trish Magyar will provide a list to everyone with their month.
9. **Chief Referee** – Chris Baning: Have been receiving referee applications, and working with several SCTP coaches to encourage their athletes to become certified.

IV. OLD BUSINESS. Club of the Year: Andrew Bielman – Criteria revised to include clubs must throw registered targets in the “most recent” shooting year and previous shooting year in order to be eligible. Still waiting for data on “junior” participation in 2025 from NSSA in order to finalize the results for 2026 Club of the Year.

V. NEW BUSINESS:

- A.** State Shoot Budget – Trish Magyar presented the budget. DGC has requested a 1¢/target (\$1/100) increase. The last increase was two years ago. We would need to increase the entry fee the same amount. MSA received a \$1,000 State Shoot grant from the NSSA to be used for an entry gift for all participants. Several options were presented, and the Board agreed on a “target orange” insulated tumbler imprinted with this year’s logo. Budget for the entry gift was set at \$1,500 maximum. There will also be a slight increase in the price of T-shirts (mostly just \$1) due to increase cost.

MOTION by Sean Rosencrantz, **SUPPORT** by Andrew Bielman, to approve the 2026 State Shoot budget. (Approved budget attached.)

- B.** State Shoot – Last year’s Class 2nd and 3rd “coin” awards were not ordered, so will rectify that when this year’s awards are procured. The inlay color for the 2026 participant pin will match the color of the entry gift tumblers. Tyler Wildman thought that a “balloon arch” (like what you would see at a graduation party or prom) might be a nice addition behind the awards podium. Estimated cost is about \$200. Need to assess the practicality, given that it is frequently windy. Jim Berg will work with Andrew Bielman on the order for the pins and coins; Scott Crosby will head up advertising and donations (form attached); Jim Berg will handle T-shirts; Class 1st and Sub-Jr and Jr belt buckles have

been ordered; Tyler Wildman will produce the State Shoot program booklet. Tyler Wildman requested that Collegiate RU, and possibly 3rd, awards be added for 2027.

- C.** State Shoot logo – Amanda Wildman submitted two logos for consideration. It was decided to use one this year, and the other next year. (Copy of logos attached.)
- D.** CD to mature on September 7, 2026. Will review finances after the State Shoot to assess if we want to increase the amount.
- E.** Tyler Wildman proposed that MSA consider “extending” its Junior Membership to include College-aged members, by making it a “Youth” membership for individuals who are 21 or under on January 1st, and enrolled as a fulltime student. Sean Rosencrantz will review the bylaws to verify if any changes are required, and we will revisit the proposal at the October Board meeting.
- F.** If “E.” above is approved, Tyler Wildman suggested that any college/university that signs-up ALL the members of their shooting team in the MSA receive a free, ½ page ad in the State Shoot program. He estimates the additional income from dues will be more than the sale of an ad.
- G.** NSSA. Al Magyar was asked about the World Shoot Free Entry. It was discontinued because analysis showed that, with very exceptions, the winners of the free entry had already planned to attend; it wasn’t an incentive to get someone to go to the World Shoot. NSSA is putting more money towards dinners during shoot-offs, and other activities to benefit the shooters. We have four individuals running for the four NSSA Director positions for Michigan: Andrew Bielman, Jason Johnson, Trish Magyar and Tyler Wildman.
- H.** Loraine Malloy, at the request of the Michigan Sporting Clays Association, determined the amount of financial support Michigan clubs and ranges have received from the MidwayUSA Foundation. From 2021-2025, nearly \$570,000 in grants were received in 1-to-1 matching funds from the MidwayUSA Foundation for range development, resulting in over \$1M in improvements. This program is open to any club that has some form of youth shooting program, and the funds can be used for a wide array of projects. A youth shooting team with a MidwayUSA Foundation Endowment account must apply for the grant, with the club where the grant is to be used, co-signing the grant application.
